TUITION EXPLANATION

The tuition rates for the 2025–2026 school year are reached after reviewing and evaluating the 2024–2025 expenses and determining the projections for the 2025–2026 school year.

- Increase in teacher salaries based on cost of living expenses.
- Increase in benefits for the teachers and support staff.
- Increases in operating expenses such as heating, cooling, and school supplies
- Continued investment in the infrastructure of our school. (Learning materials, renovations, repairs, technology, etc.)
- Decrease school deficit.

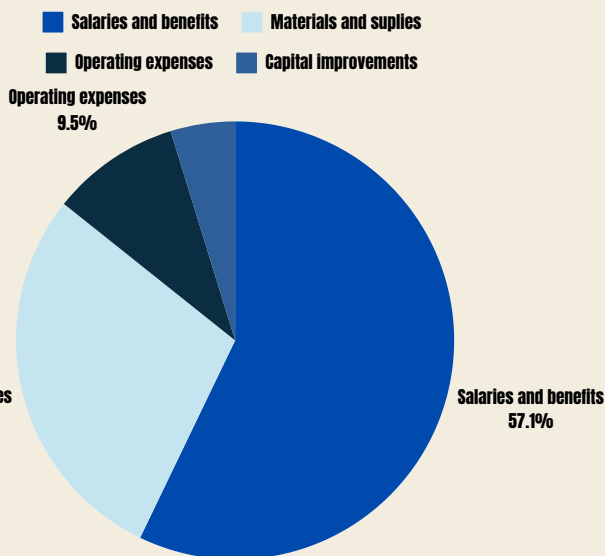

## 2025-2026 Mandatory Fee Schedule

<b>PreK – 8 Registration Fee per Family: The registration fee is due at the time of registration. THE REGISTRATION FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE.</b>	<b>\$250</b>
PreK-8 Curriculum Fee per Family: \$300 curriculum fee will be paid through FACTS on July 1st. This fee is used to provide the curricular resources for students. The fee is used to help purchase Math, ELA, Religion, and Science materials.	\$300
<b>FACTS FEE per Family:</b> Fee is charged by FACTS for account set up	\$45
